Bring your creativity to the Western Galilee and connect with people through collaboration, an arts festival and a community-based project

USE YOUR TALENT TO CONNECT WITH PEOPLE

Are you an artist who loves to collaborate with people? Are you a musician who enjoys sharing your passion for music and teaching others? Are you interested in theater and would enjoy sharing your knowledge? We are looking for anyone in a creative field (actors, art therapists, musicians/conductors, fine artists, photographers, etc.) who would like to volunteer their time and talents in the Western Galilee.

This is an opportunity to make personal connections with people and discover the creativity and art programs of the area. This program includes the opportunity to participate in a local arts festival called 'Art on the Fence,' to create and collaborate with local residents on a project, to build relationships with local artists, and discover art-related sites in the region. Artists must provide a completed AIR (Artist in Residency) Application and 4 examples of your recent work.

WESTERN GALILEE AIR EXAMPLE ITINERARY:

- May 16 Depart Ben Gurion Airport via train, travel north to the Western Galilee, welcome & introduction to P2G, a meal with staff and Arts Task Force members
- May 17 Breakfast, tour the old city of Akko; visit the Ethnographic Museum and Akko market, lunch, travel to Kibbutz Geshar Haziv to prepare for The Fence Festival, evening dinner with local artists
- May 18 Breakfast, workshop with local artists, lunch, The Fence Festival, home hospitality Shabbat dinner
- May 19 Breakfast, The Fence Festival, free afternoon/evening
- May 20 Breakfast, projects with community members, lunch, tour of Rosh Hanikra and northern border, free time, home hospitality dinner
- May 21 Breakfast, projects with community members, lunch and tour of the Ghetto Fighters House Museum and Moshe Kaupferman Museum, free time, home hospitality dinner
- May 22 Breakfast, tour Pkiin and Tzfat: "Kabalaistic Art", lunch at Hameiri, dinner in Nahariya, arts event and/or performance in the evening
- May 23 Breakfast, projects with community members, lunch and tour of Kibbutz Cabri: The Gottesman Etching Center, free evening
- May 24 Breakfast, projects with community members, lunch, summary meeting, final dinner party and close of program, depart the following morning on May 25th after breakfast



COSTS

The artist or local community provides:

- Round trip airfare
- Health insurance
- Any additional private meals or activities

Partnership with Israel provides:

- Lodging, and transportation to art sites
- Breakfast, lunch and home hospitality dinners
- Scheduled local trips in the Western Galilee
- Art materials
